

Cabernet Sauvignon

The international grape variety with very noticeable tannins.



Often vinified as a **blend** or in **oak barrels**, Cabernet Sauvignon has a very intense colour together with notes of dark berries and tobacco. In the mouth, it offers good tannins that are often harmonised by barrel ageing.

A little secret about **Cabernet Sauvignon**: it is best kept in the cellar to allow it to develop completely.

A **grape variety** that originally comes from Bordeaux, Cabernet Sauvignon is one of the most widely planted **varieties** in the world.
