Humagne Blanche is one of the **grape varieties** that are native to Valais.

Historically renowned for producing enormous quantities of **grapes** on each vine, **Humagne Blanche** undergoes strict pruning by wine-growers.

Humagne Blanche is characterised by a very floral nose. In the mouth, it is complex with high acidity. A wine for cellaring.

A little secret about **Humagne Blanche**: for a long time, this wine was considered the 'new mothers' wine', thanks to its high iron content. However, it contains the same iron levels as other wines – it's an old wives' tale, then.
