

# Marsanne (Ermitage)

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The grape variety with multiple appellations.



A French grape variety from the Côtes-du-Rhône, **Marsanne** (known as Ermitage in Valais) was first planted in **Valais** in the 19th century.

Its grapes produce rich wines with aromas of red fruit, vinified both as dry and dessert **wine**.

A little secret about **Marsanne**: a bold variety that is not afraid to grow in dry, infertile soil.
